Students are advised to take all 1000/2000-level courses prior to the 3000-level courses in the minor. ECO 2030 can also be used to satisfied General Education requirements. Students not admitted to the College of Business may take, at most, five business courses at the 3000 or 4000 level (unless more is required by a business minor or non-business major). Students must have 57 hours to take FIN 3680, MGT 3630, and MKT 3050 and 60 hours to take FIN 3010 and MGT 3010. In addition, students not admitted to the COB must have a minimum GPA of 2.0 to take 3000/4000 level business classes. A minimum overall GPA of 2.0 is required for the courses included in the minor.
